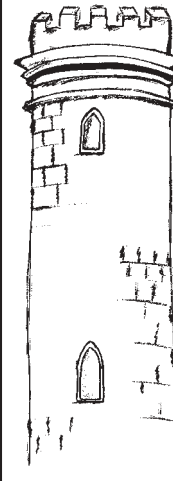

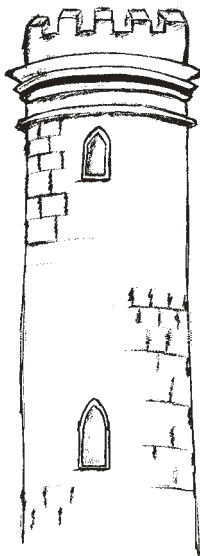

**AN INTRODUCTION TO OUR BIS & GROUP JUDGES**

**BEST IN SHOW - JUDGE MARTIN SAUNDERS - CASTELL COCH**

Martin was born into the world of dogs continuing three generations of a doggy family, since the mid 60s he has been involved at all levels i.e. showing, breeding judging and administration. Martin's first judging appointment was on 1 January 1983 and since then has progressed through the ranks to his current status, currently being approved to award CCs to: Fourteen breeds within the Hound Group and one in the Gundog Group. At Open Show level Martin judges breeds within the Terrier/ Pastoral/Utility Groups. Overseas appointments have seen Martin visit South Africa, Finland, Malta, Australia, Russia and Sweden. Due to Martin's hectic judging schedule he decided to step down from showing seven years ago. Martin's memberships include The KC and SWKA and is Secretary of Cardiff Canine Society and Chairman of the Akita Club of Wales.

**PASTORAL GROUP JUDGE - LIZ DUNHILL - FANTASA**

I have had a life long involved in dogs, starting with obedience training. I moved onto dog showing some 30 years ago. My affix being Fantasa Team Vormund, and was trained in the USA by an All Breeds Pro Handler. I have bred champions in 5 breeds, Rottweilers, Akita, Shiba, S.C.W.T. and most recent C.K.C.S. my dogs have won 11 all breeds CH SHOW B.I.S. and numerous groups including Crufts. I have had 2 breeds in the top ten, culminating in NO 2 All Breeds with A Rottweiler. I have bred/owned the breed record holder dog and bitch in Rotts Shibas, and am currently the all time top winning kennel in those breeds I am a dog groomer and behaviourist. I re-train owners and dogs with canine problems. And have developed a show dog whisperer course in order to help the show fraternity with all related behavioural issues and handling skills. I am President of the Japanese Shiba Inu Club of GB. I am responsible for Judges Education and breed specific seminars. I have been responsible for the Breed specific JDP on Rotts and Shibas. I have judged and given seminars world wide. And have judged many seiger style shows in Rottweilers in Europe USA and the Rottweiler Nationals in Australia. Shiba Specialty shows in USA and Norway. I have judged at Crufts 3 times and International shows All Winners Amsterdam, Denmark, France Spain and Belgium in October.

**TOY GROUP JUDGE - LYNN WEBSTER - POMLYNN**

A1, LIST for POMS (have given 12 sets of CCs) including Cruft's 2001. B, LIST for Bichons, Italian Greyhounds, & Havanese. C LIST for Papillion's. I am a member of the K. C. and also K. C. representative for the Pomeranian's. I am Founder Member, Past Chairperson, and now Vice President, Hon/Secretary, Treasurer of the Northern Pom Club. I have judged most of the Toy Breeds at open show level, Toy Groups and B.I.S. since 1982. I was a Past Secretary of Chesterfield Canine Society, and presently Secretary of Spire Toy Dog Society.

**TERRIER GROUP - MAUREEN BROADSTOCK - ARAD**

Having been introduced to the world of dogs through Alan - we have not been without a dog at home since our marriage. We briefly showed a W.F.T. in 1962 but while the children were growing up we had Cocker spaniels at home for 12 years. In the late '70s we started showing S.B.Ts with some success under the ARAD affix. A Bulldog bitch joined the 'gang' on our show circuit in the early '90s and later on a P.R.T too. We currently share our settee with a C.K.C Spaniel and a Pug. I joined Alan on the Western S.B.T. Society committee in 1986, and became Secretary of the Society in 1989. I remained in office until 2000. I also served on the P.R.T. Club as Treasurer from 1993 to 2003. Both Alan & I became involved with local Canine Societies in the early 1980s and I took over as Hon. Secretary of Treharris & D.C. Society in 1989 - an office I hold to date. I award Challenge Certificates in S.B.Ts & P.R.Ts & have judged both breeds extensively abroad. I have been fortunate too to have judged all seven groups of breeds to Best in Show at Open Show level in the U.K.

### UTILITY GROUP – MELANIE REED-PECK – BYQUY

I have handled all the dogs at BYQUY from the age of eight as well as a number of other breeds while in Germany and Italy. I have been judging since 1980. At championship show level I judge Keeshonds, Bulldogs, French Bulldogs, Schipperkes, St Bernards & Irish Water Spaniels and I have judged a number of breeds across all groups at Open show level in the UK also judging both in Europe and Australia and awarding Green Stars in Ireland in Bostons Terriers, Japanese Spitz. I am on the 'B' list for Tibetan Spaniels and 'C' list for Japanese Spitz and have a general interest in all breeds in the Utility Group.

### GUNDOG GROUP – ALAN BROADSTOCK – ARAD

Alan has been involved in dogs for over 40 years and has enjoyed the company of a variety of breeds living at home with him over the years. He showed a W.F.T. in the early 1960s, but when family commitments prevented further involvement in showing until the late 1970's several golden Cocker spaniels shared their home for some 12 years. He, along with his wife Maureen, started showing Staffordshire Bull Terriers under the ARAD affix and later - a Parson Russell Terrier. He joined the committee of the Western S.B.T. Society in 1983, and served as the Show Manager at many of the Society's shows over the years. He was made a Life Vice President of this Society in 2001. In partnership with Mr Adrian Bell, they own several quality Parson Russell Terriers under the TWOMATES affix. He is currently the Chairman of Treharris & District Canine Society, a position he has held for 20 years. He was also an active committee member of the Parson Russell Terrier Club from 1993 to 2003. He awards Challenge Certificates in S.B.T.s & P.R.T.s and has judged these breeds extensively both in U.K. and abroad - Moscow (1); Israel (2); Germany (4); Finland (1); Eire (4); Sweden (1); N. Ireland (1); S. Africa – all Terrier Breeds & Terrier Group (1). At Tel Aviv International Show 1994 he was passed by the F.C.I. to judge Bull Terriers & Staffordshire Bull Terriers & award C.C.s or CACs/CACIBS in both breeds at the show. In 2000, he was passed to award C.C.s in all Terrier breeds, and judge a Terrier Group by the Kennel Union of Southern Africa. He currently judges all seven groups of breeds to Best in Show at Open Show level in the U.K. He is very proud to have judged P.R.Ts at the Breed Club Championship Show – November 2004 and at CRUFTS - March 2006. He is also very proud to be contracted to judge S.B.Ts at Birmingham Dog Show Society Ltd. in 2006 and at CRUFTS - March 2009.

### WORKING GROUP – COLIN DOWSON – OZZYPOOL

I have been in dogs for a few years now mostly Pastoral and Working breeds but for 19 years I have been involved with Australian Shepherds which I give Challenge Certificates in. I have judged at all levels open and Champ shows both here and in Europe doing specialty's in Belgium and Recently In Holland. I have previously judged the Terrier, Working, and Pastoral Groups at open show level. I have been a member and was involved with Merseyside Boxer Club in the past. I am honoured to be asked to judge the Australian Shepherd at Crufts 2013. I would like to thank the committee for asking me to judge at your show.

### HOUND GROUP – JOANNE SMITH – ZHAQQARI

### DEFINITION OF CLASSES

In the following definitions a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in Breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won all wins up to & including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class ie. **18<sup>th</sup> October 2009.**

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering for Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A First prize does not include a Special prize of whatever value. A dog is not eligible for entry in Variety classes (excluding AVNSC Classes) unless also entered & subsequently exhibited in a Breed class where such a class is provided for which it is eligible. Exemptions from this regulation are:

1. A puppy, unless a class for dogs under 12 months of age for which it is eligible is provided for the Breed.
2. A dog in Any Variety Veteran class.
3. A dog in Any Variety Champion class.
4. As provided in Annex A to Kennel Club F Regulations.
5. A dog which is withdrawn from exhibition in breed classes as a result of the appointment of an emergency judge.

If an exhibitor reports before judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

1. Withdrawal - the dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) & 20.
2. Transfer - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy & Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.  
b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior class, which is over age but under 12 calendar months or 18 calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.  
c) For any reason other than above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.  
d) If an exhibitor arrives late & misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

**MINOR PUPPY:** For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

**PUPPY:** For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

**JUNIOR:** For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the day of the Show.

**NOVICE:** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First prizes at Open or Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy & Special Puppy Classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

**POST GRADUATE:** For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit or Open Classes, whether restricted or not.

**OPEN:** For all dogs of the breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at this Show.

**VETERAN:** For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the day of the Show.  
**AV IMPORTED REGISTER:** For breeds confirmed to the Imported Breeds Register and only when an Interim Breed Standard has been published by The Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class only, and are ineligible for any other competition whatsoever.

**ANY VARIETY NOT NFC:** For breeds of dog for which no separate breed classes are scheduled. Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed. **All dogs accepted NFC must be SIX calendar months or over and KC registered. Full KC details must be given on the entry form.**

## RULES & REGULATIONS

1. OPENING OF SHOW: The Show will open at 8.30am.
2. RECEIPT OF DOGS: Dogs will be received at any time but it is the responsibility of the exhibitor to have exhibits available for judging.
3. JUDGING TIME: All judging will commence at 9.30am.
4. CLOSE OF SHOW: The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed at which time dogs must be removed. REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS. Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club.
5. COOKING STOVES: The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of the tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
6. FEES: **Members** - £4.00 Per Dog - Subsequent Entries with same dog £1.00 ~ including JHA; **Non-Members** - £5.00 Per Dog - Subsequent Entries with same dog £1.00 ~ including JHA; Not for Competition (Full KC details on entry form) - £2.50; Dot Crowther Members Stakes FREE ( Must have paid Membership); CATALOGUES: Pre-paid ONLY - £3.00 with entries.
7. PRIZE MONEY: Stakes classes only - 1st £3 :2nd £2 :3rd £1:4th 50p
8. REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
9. PUPPIES: Puppies under **six** calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
10. MATING OF BITCHES: The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
11. BEST PUPPY IN SHOW (if Scheduled): Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same show. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the show. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it will automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed, Best in Group and Best in Show respectively.
  - 1). Best Puppy in Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from puppies which have been judged and which are unbeaten by any other puppy.
  - 2). Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners provided they are unbeaten by any other puppy.
  - 3). Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show maybe withdrawn from all other competition, other than Breed Classes and Best Puppy in Breed, prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show in order to remain unbeaten. A puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy in Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Puppies may be withdrawn from AV Classes when judged before Breed Classes.

PROVISO: For the purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
12. BEST IN SHOW: The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed & is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show.
  - (a) Best of Breed. Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed must be declared. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be selected for which the Best of Breed must be declared from those exhibits which have received an award.
  - (b) Shows judged on the Group System (Definition; Shows judged on the Group System includes classes for breeds within more than one Group, as defined in Kennel Club Regulation (B (A)); and require a judge to declare a Best of each Group after which the exhibits so declared will compete for the award of Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show.)
    1. Best of Group Best of Group and subsequent placings must be selected from - (a) The Best of Breed winners in each Group provided that they are unbeaten winning dogs. (b) The Best unbeaten winning dog from Any variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day.
    2. Best in Show Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners provided they are unbeaten. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection for Best in Show.
  - (c) WITHDRAWAL FROM OTHER COMPETITION Dogs which become eligible for Best of Group and Best in Show maybe withdrawn from all other competition other than breed classes and Best

- of Breed prior to the competition for Best of Group or Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best in Group or Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Dogs may be withdrawn from AV Classes when judged before Breed Classes.

PROVISO: For the Purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace & Team or a Special Award confined to a single breed, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.

## REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITIONS F (B)

1. These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these show regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.(a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained there. (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these regulations, he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under rule A42.
2. (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show. (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:  
(a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee. (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown. Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination & analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by any official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show & the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.
