## Kennel Club Breeders Competition 2009

The following Awards are offered: **Best Breeder in Breed**  
**Best Breeder in Group 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th**  
**Grand Final at Crufts 2010**



The following requirements apply to entries for these awards:

1. Breeders wishing to enter the competition should first purchase a Breeders Competition Record Book from the Kennel Club or from the show secretary.
2. The Breeder enters for the award in his/her name and is responsible for arranging which exhibits form their breeder group, or team
3. The Breeder must complete the Record Book accurately with all necessary details before presenting it to the show organisers.
4. The Breeder is responsible for obtaining the necessary authority to compete from the show organisers (or designated official such as the Ring Steward) to compete for the award.
5. The Breeder's team must comprise four exhibits of the same breed, all of which must be entered in a class at the show.
6. A Breeder may enter more than one team per show.
7. All dogs must have the same registered breeder.
8. The 'beaten dog' rule will NOT apply.
9. Best Breeder in Breed goes through to a Best Breeder in Group award.
10. Twenty points are required to qualify for Finals at Crufts in the following year. Points are cumulative over a calendar year and are gained as follows:
 

Breed win 1 point	Fourth in Group 1 point	Third in Group 2 points
Second in Group 3 points	First in Group 4 points	

Breeders gaining 20 points should apply to the Canine Activities Department at the Kennel Club to apply for the Crufts Final. After amassing 20 points a breeder cannot enter any further Best Breeder Competitions for that calendar year.

Competition record books will be signed in the Secretarys office.

1. OPENING OF SHOW: The Show will open at 7.30 am
2. ARRIVAL OF DOGS: Dogs will be received until 11.30 am after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional & unforeseen circumstances & by special permission of the Show Management.
3. JUDGING TIME: Judging will commence at 9.30 am.
4. REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS. Exhibits may be removed after their judging has been completed. Exhibits may not be removed any earlier unless by written order of the Veterinary Surgeon or of the Show Management and then only in very exceptional and unforeseen circumstances which must be reported to the Kennel Club. CLOSE OF SHOW: The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed at which time dogs must be removed
5. COOKING STOVES: The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of the tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
6. FEES: Breeds with CC's Members - £20.50, Non-Members £22.00. Breeds without CC's \*\*\* (inc Champion & Veteran Stakes) Members £8.00, Non-members £9.50. All subsequent entries with same dog £2.00. Catalogues; £4.00 prepaid with entries, £4.50 on the day (Limited number available on day, please order with entries). Membership: £4.00 Single, £6.00 Joint, 50p Junior. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best of Breed, Best in Group or Best in Show is a puppy it will automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Similarly, if the Reserve Best of Breed, Reserve Best of Group or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed, Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Breed, Best in Group and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.
  - 1) BEST PUPPY IN BREED: A Best Puppy must be declared in each breed from puppies entered in the breed classes.
  - 2) BEST PUPPY IN GROUP: Best Puppy in Group and subsequent Puppy Group placings must be selected from:-
    - (a) Those puppies declared Best Puppy in Breed provided that they are unbeaten by any other puppy.

## Rules & Regs Contd.

11. (cont)
- (b) The puppy declared Best Puppy from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day provided it is unbeaten by any other puppy.
- 3) **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW:** Best Puppy in Show must be selected from the Best Puppy in Group winners provided they are unbeaten by any other puppy.
- WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITION:** Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition, other than breed classes and Best Puppy in Breed, prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Group and Best Puppy in Show as appropriate, in order to remain unbeaten. A puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Group or Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy in Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Puppies may be withdrawn from Any Variety Classes when judged before Breed Classes. **PROVISO:** For the purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
12. **BEST IN SHOW:** The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed and is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show.
- a.) **BEST OF BREED:** Where a breed is separately classified a Best of Breed must be declared from those exhibits which have received an award. Where separate classes are provided for each sex of a breed a Best of each Sex must be selected from which the Best of Breed must be declared from those exhibits which have received an award.
- b) **Shows Judged on the Group System:** (Definition; Shows judged on the Group System includes classes for breeds within more than one Group, as defined in Kennel Club Regulation B(A); and requires a judge to declare a Best of each Group after which the exhibits so declared will compete for the award of Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show.)
- 1) **BEST OF GROUP:** Best of Group and subsequent Group placings must be selected from:-
- (a) The Best of Breed winners in each group provided that they are unbeaten winning dogs.
- (b) The best unbeaten winning dog from the Any Variety Not Separately Classified classes in each group or on each day.
- 2) **BEST IN SHOW:** Best in Show must be selected from the Best of Group winners provided they are unbeaten. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Group winners following the selection of Best in Show.
- Withdrawal from other Competition:** Dogs which become eligible for Best of Group and Best in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition other than breed classes and Best of Breed prior to the competition for Best of Group or Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best of Group or Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show however, must not compete in any subsequent competition. Dogs may be withdrawn from Any Variety Classes when judged before Breed Classes. **PROVISO:** For the purposes of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace and Team or a Special Award confined to a single breed, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.
13. **ADMISSION TO GROUPS:** Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
14. **SCHEDULE AMENDMENTS:** No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the General Committee of The Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.
15. **PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION:** All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
16. **OVERSEAS EXHIBITORS:** All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
17. Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
- 1) When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
- 2) If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
- 3) The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.

## Rules & Regs Contd.

- 4) Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
- 5) When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
- 6) Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
- 7) Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.
- WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.**
- Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
18. **NOT FOR COMPETITION:** Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered must be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered
19. **RULES & REGULATIONS:** The Show will be held under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations. All rules, definitions or instructions of the nature of Rules and Regulations printed for convenience in other parts of this Schedule shall be deemed to be Regulations for this Show, and shall have the same effect as if they formed part of these regulations.
20. **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF ENTRIES:** If acknowledgement of entries is required, an addressed, stamped card with "Receipt" written on the reverse should be enclosed.
21. **BANK CHARGES:** Any bank charges incurred by the Society through incorrectly completed or dishonoured cheques will be passed on to the exhibitor concerned at a charge of £20 per transaction. Any exhibitor failing to pay fees and/or bank charges will be dealt with by the Committee of the Kennel Club. **An Administration Charge** of £5.00 will be levied on all Entry Forms not filled in correctly and sent back to exhibitors.
22. **POWER TO EXCLUDE:** The Show Management may exclude or remove any dog which in their opinion or that of the Judge is not in a fit state for exhibition.
23. **BENCHING & RING NUMBERS:** Exhibitors' dogs of the same breed entered for the Show will be benched together and all dogs will be benched in catalogue order. No bench numbers may be changed from one bench to another and no dog shall be benched on any but its own numbered pen. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES MAY PARTITIONS BETWEEN DOGS BE REMOVED** (KC Show Reg 17). Every exhibitor shall ensure that whilst the dog is being exhibited, its handler shall display the correct ring number.
24. **RESPONSIBILITY:** The Committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of, or damage to any dog, person or property whether arising from accident or other causes whatever or from any act or omission of itself, its officers, agents, servants, or others or the damage done by the exhibitor to any person or property.
- 25. PASSES: One FREE Pass will be issued for each exhibit.**
26. **CATALOGUES:** Catalogues will be available on the day and application for catalogue vouchers should be made with entries. Price £4.00 (£4.50 on the day). The list of exhibits and exhibitors published in the Catalogue is errors and omissions excepted.
27. **GANGWAYS:** Gangways MUST be kept clear at all times. Any obstructions, including dog boxes, left in gangways will be removed by the Show Management.
28. **ORDER OF JUDGING:** A provisional order of judging will be published in the canine press in advance, but this is subject to change by the Show Management.
29. **PHOTOGRAPHS:** No entry into any ring during any part of judging is permitted for the purpose of taking photographs. **Photography will NOT be permitted for commercial or advertising purposes unless by written agreement by the show management. Rules & Regs Contd.**
30. **DOG FOULING:** Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is requested to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog/s at any Kennel Club Licensed Show within the licensed venue & within the environs of that event including car & caravan parks & approaches. Adequate receptacles for the disposal of such fouling will be provided.
31. **CONVERSATION WITH JUDGE:** Conversation is NOT allowed in the ring. Exhibitors showing dogs are not permitted to hold conversation with the judge. After being requested not to do so by the ring steward, the Judge or any member of the Committee, the exhibitor will be reported to the Kennel Club. No persons other than the exhibitors (officials excepted) will be allowed in the ring during the judging of classes or specials.
32. **DOGS IN CARS:** Remedial action will be taken in the event of dogs left in cars being found in a distressed condition.

## Rules & Regs Contd.

33. CONTROL OF DOGS: The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car & caravan parks & approaches.
34. DISQUALIFICATION: A dog may be disqualified by the General Committee from any award, whether an objection has been lodged or not, if proved amongst other things to have been registered or recorded as having been bred by the scheduled Judge. This shall not apply to a Judge appointed in an emergency.

## DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

In the following definitions a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club. Wins at Championship Shows in Breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society. In estimating the number of awards won all wins up to & including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class ie. **23<sup>rd</sup> September 2008**.

Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering for Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A First prize does not include a Special prize of whatever value. A dog is not eligible for entry in Variety classes (excluding AVNSC Classes) unless also entered & subsequently exhibited in a Breed class where such a class is provided for which it is eligible. Exemptions from this regulation are:

1. A puppy, unless a class for dogs under 12 months of age for which it is eligible is provided for the Breed.
2. A dog in Any Variety Veteran class.
3. A dog in Any Variety Champion class.
4. As provided in Annex A to Kennel Club F Regulations.
5. A dog which is withdrawn from exhibition in breed classes as a result of the appointment of an emergency judge.

If an exhibitor reports before judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

1. **Withdrawal** - the dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) & 20.
2. **Transfer** - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy & Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.  
b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior class, which is over age but under 12 calendar months or 18 calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.  
c) For any reason other than above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.  
d) If an exhibitor arrives late & misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

- MINOR PUPPY:** For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
- PUPPY:** For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
- JUNIOR:** For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.
- YEARLING:** For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four months of age on the first day of the Show.

## Definitions Contd

### NOVICE:

For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First prizes at Open or Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy & Special Puppy classes excepted, whether restricted or not).

### POST GRADUATE:

For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not.

### LIMIT:

For dogs which have not become show Champions under the Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won seven or more First prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes, confined to the breed, whether restricted or not, at Shows where Challenge certificates were offered for the breed.

### OPEN:

For all dogs of the Breeds for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the Show.

### VETERAN:

For dogs of not less than 7 years of age on the first day of the Show.

### CHAMPION:

For dogs, which have been confirmed, a Champion, Show Champion or Field Trial Champion. Champion classes may not be scheduled for individual breeds or varieties of breeds

### IMPORT REGISTER:

# For breeds confined to the Imported Register and only when an interim Breed Standard has been published by The Kennel Club. Such breeds may be exhibited in this class only, and are ineligible for any other competition whatsoever.

### AVNSC:

For breeds of dogs for which no separate breed classes are scheduled.

### NFC:

Societies may at their discretion, accept Not for Competition entries. Societies may accept such entries from breeds of dog not included within the title of the Society and at Shows held over more than one day, such entries may be accepted on any day from any breed. **All dogs accepted NFC must be SIX calendar months or over and KC registered. Full KC details must be given on the entry form.**

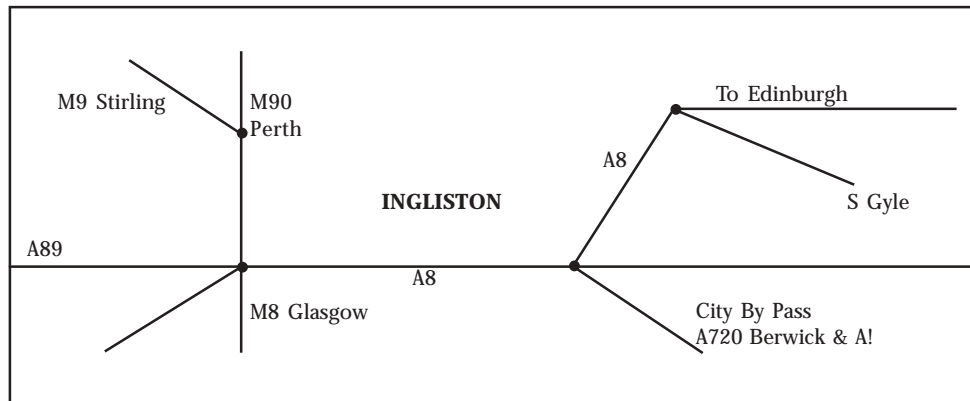

# BACK OF ENTRY FORM

## REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F (B)

1. These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these show regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.(a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained there. (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these regulations, he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under rule A42.
2. (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show. (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:  
(a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee. (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown. Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination & analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by any official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show & the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

The Officers & Committee of The Working & Pastoral Breeds Association of Scotland do not accept responsibility for any products advertised or sold by Stall Holders and/or Trade Stands at this Show. Exhibitors are reminded that products on sale by Trade Stands for the preparation & grooming of dogs may not meet the requirements for the Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.

### **Dogs in Cars on Hot Days**
